

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the project to make new maps of the reservation is progressing well, and

WHEREAS, it was planned that the mapping project would be followed by a project to place road sign posts on reservation roads to aid in field travel and map utilization, and


WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee at their May 2nd Meeting indicated a desire to proceed with the sign project.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is directed and authorized to prepare detailed plans for the sign project, to pursue various funding sources, and sign any and all documents necessary to consummate the project.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
