

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the livestock associations and the General Livestock are having financial difficulties, and

WHEREAS, the new grazing fees of \$6.00 per unit per year will work a hardship upon the livestock industry, and

WHEREAS, the new fees have been adopted and are felt to be equitable in normal times.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that the \$2.00 per unit per year fees remain effective for one (1) year from the date of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that therefore the \$6.00 fee is deferred and that the \$2.00 fee be charged with \$1.00 being returned to the associations for use in capital improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new fees of \$6.00 per unit per year will be in full force, effective one (1) year from the date of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
