## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority is in need of a director who is experienced in matters regarding the operation of the Housing Authority program, and
- WHEREAS, two applicants, Bob Curley and Leander Massey have the qualifications necessary to efficiently operate the Housing Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority is hereby authorized to employ Bob Curley and Leander Massey if the Housing Authority finds that each applicant meets all necessary requirements for such a position.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign contracts of employment with the applicants.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
