

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed an outstanding bill with the Ken Patton Public Relations Firm, and

WHEREAS, there were some questions as to the authorization of these expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the total bill due the Ken Patton Agency was \$3,389.15.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Administrative Manager be authorized, from funds available, to pay the bill as submitted on a voucher.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action is considered to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that the Chairman will establish procedures for future authorization of the public relations activity.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
