RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Assembly of God Congregation came before the Tribal Council to discuss an annual date for a camp meeting, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is in concurrence with the Assembly of God camp meeting being held on the first Sunday in June through the third Sunday of each year, and
- WHEREAS, the June meeting have seemed to have been more successful because of the weather.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Assembly of God Camp Meetings in Lower Cedar Creek are hereby scheduled annually for the period from the first Sunday in June to the third Sunday in June as the annual date.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the council hereby authorizes this annual camp meeting as an annual event until changed by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
