

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to establish a position of Probate and Census Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this position is urgent, and

WHEREAS, the funding of this position will not require an additional appropriation of tribal monies.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Administrative Manager be directed to establish a position for Probate and Census Clerk and develop an adequate position description and recruit for the position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding for this position be from savings in the current budget or any other source available to the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that travel and per diem for this position be established at the normal tribal rate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council anticipates that the incumbent must travel to Globe, Arizona to receive training and instructions to adequately qualify for the probate part of the position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the instructions for the incumbent on the census position will be given by the Tribal Statistician at designated times.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
