WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the operation of the Tribal Work Experience Program, and


WHEREAS, it was evident that the complete program cannot be had without additional operating expense, and

WHEREAS, the tribe desires to supplement the Tribal Work Experience budget with \$600.00 for the purchase of gas and oil.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Work Experience Program be granted \$600.00 for the purchase of gas and oil.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Six-Hundred-dollar grant come from contingency or any other source of surplus funds in the present tribal budget.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
