


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has tentatively scheduled the widening and overlay of State Route 73, Post Office Canyon to Whiteriver, Project No. S-215-507, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is requesting permission to work on the Diamond Creek turnout for the Diamond Creek access beyond the existing right-of-way.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation to work on said access a distance of 200 feet outside the right-of-way.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
