RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the local Red Cross Chapter has requested supplemental funds for the operation of the chapter, and
- WHEREAS, it's the council's understanding that this supplemental fund grant will be used for communications to assist the needy, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Office has indicated that these funds can come from savings.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a Six-Hundred. (\$600.00) Grant be given to the local Red Cross Chapter for the use in communications and assistance for emergency situations.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$600.00 grant will be taken from savings from the 1975-1976 Fiscal Year and no additional appropriation will be required.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
