- RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 75-144 passed August 12, 1975 was rescinded, and WHEREAS, the Tribal Council re-evaluated the cash reserve of the tribe, and WHEREAS, upon reconsiderations, the Council's opinion of the cash reserve has changed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 75-144, authorizing the Chairman to enter into an agreement for the production of "Savage American", be rescinded in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council has pledged themselves for further action to more carefully evaluate budget expenditures and budget amendments in light of the true tribal financial standing.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
