RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHERMAS, it is in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for it to continue its united involvement in matters of widespread concern to all Indica Tribes by maintaining continued membership in the National Congress of American Indians, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires that the White Mountain Apache Tribe continue its membership in the National Congress of American Indians for 1975-76, and
- WHEREAS, the Write Mountain Apache Tribe meets all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to the Constitution of the National Congress of American Indians (Article II, Sec. 1, b).
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Vice Chairman of the Tribe to join the National Congress of American Indians.
- BE IT FURTHER REGOLVED that Tribal funds in the amount of \$195.00 based on the Tribal Membership dues schedule of the National Congress of American Indians By-Laws (Article III, Sec. 1, b), are authorized to be paid for such Tribal Membership.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that based on membership of 7000 as verified by tribal records, the Tribe shall have 170 votes according to the National Congress of American Indians Constitution (Article IV, Sec. 3).
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Article V, Sec. 2 of the Constitution, the Tribe designates Ivan Kitcheyan and Ronnie Lupe who are members of the National Congress of American Indians in good standing, to be its official representatives to the National Congress of American Indians, and designates Lafe Altaha and John R. Quintero also members of the National Congress of American Indians in good standing, to be the alternate representatives.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
