

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Eunice DeRose was selected in January, 1975 to the position of Probate Clerk for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court, and

WHEREAS, Eunice DeRose was going to train a local member for that position, and

WHEREAS, the proposed position for Probate Clerk has not been established and filled.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mrs. Eunice DeRose be appointed as Probate Clerk for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council will select the individual to fill the training position and be trained in that capacity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this appointment of Mrs. Eunice DeRose be on the same terms and conditions as the appointment in January, 1975.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
