



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has accepted the recommendation of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board for establishing non-member hunting, fishing and camping permit fees for 1976 season, and

WHEREAS, the basic schedule was approved by the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise in the minutes of the meeting held on August 29, 1975, and

WHEREAS, the tribe's interest is in improved game management and increased resource revenues.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached fee schedule and regulations are approved:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 75-156 be rescinded in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
