WHEREAS, a review of the first six months financial statement for the 1975-76 Fiscal Year has been made by the Finance Committee, and

WHEREAS, this review indicates the need to increase certain authorized expense categories within the Tribal Budget, and


WHEREAS, these increased expenditures as outlined in the following have been recommended to the Tribal Council attachment for the approval by the Budget Committee.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget be amended to increase the expense items as listed on the attached outline.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this \$50,600.00 be withdrawn from funds on deposit in the United States Treasury for this budget amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to consummate this budget increase.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
