## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Clinton Kessay, Jr. is a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, he has negotiated with Mr. Bob Olson for the purchase of the Broken Arrow Garage at Fort Apache, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, said business sets on tribal land, and
- WHEREAS, Clinton Kessay, Jr. requests a lease on said land in order to take over the premises and operate the garage business, upon completion of the sale to him; and
- WHERFAS, the Tribal Council desires to encourage tribal members in undertaking businesses on the Fort Apache Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Clinton Kessay, Jr. is hereby granted a twenty-five year lease on the premises known as Broken Arrow Garage, mets and bounds description of which is on file at the Office of the Superintendent, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of the lease shall commence upon its date of execution, that the tribal lease fee on said land shall be waived for the first five years, to be thereafter negotiated on its fifth anniversary date.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lessee must apply for and receive a Trader's Permit.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent and the Chairman of the Tribal Council are hereby directed and authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out this resolution

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
