FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, there is a need for a road from across Preston Lupe's house to Levi Dehose's house in Cibecue; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuities Right-of-Way to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the construction;


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a Gratuities Right-of-Way be granted from the location across from Preston Lupe's house to Levi Dehose' house in Cibecue;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Agency Superintendent be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents granting the Right-of-Way.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of _____ for and _____ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
