RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has requested a site for the construction of a Fish Hatchery; and
- WHEREAS, the Community of Cibecue, the Cibecue Livestock Association, and the Tribal Land Board has approved the location; and
- WHEREAS, the Hatchery proposed has been reviewed by the Tribal Council in the December meeting and January meeting;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a land assignment be made for the Fish Hatchery that is about two (2) miles below White Springs on a water source flowing from the West bank of Cibecue Creek. The name of the Spring is C-42 and maintains a constant flow.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the West bank location contains approximately eleven (11) acres and the East bank location contains approximately ten (10) acres.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area be surveyed and that a copy of the metes and bounds survey be a record at the Tribal Office and Agency Office.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
