## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Director of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise requests that the Tribal Council authorize the approved construction of a new Enterprise Office and yard within the area designated for the Whiteriver Commercial Center, a metes and bounds description of which is on file at the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS, the Land Board approved said location for construction of the new office and yard at its January 3, 1977 meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has fully considered all aspects of placing the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise facilities at the Whiteriver Commercial Center site, and finds that same is in the beneficial interests of both the Recreation Enterprise and the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby designates a 300 feet by 300 feet (or approximately two and one-half (2½) acres) area within the Whiteriver Commercial Center Site, a metes and bounds description of which is on file at the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, for the purpose of constructing a new White Mountain Recreation Office building and yard.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
