RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist the Tribe in gaining the transfer of Mr. Harry Lester, a Bureau of Indian Affairs Plant Management employee, off the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the basis for said request yet remains a serious problem for the Tribe in that Mr. Lester has not and continues to not act in the best interests and for the welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, no action has resulted from the Tribe's request for assistance or direction from the Bureau of Indian Affairs which employs Mr. Lester.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to take such action as is necessary to remove Mr. Harry Lester, a non-Indian, from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, under the laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
