## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned about the use of tribal vehicles,
- WHEREAS, there is a great amount of unauthorized use by employees doing other than tribal business.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a Committee be established to develop a Tribal Policy on the use of Tribal Vehicles.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lafe Altaha, Carlos Nosie, West Anderson, Sr. and Lynn Cody be appointed to this Committee.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the established committee present a draft proposed policy at the Council meeting in April, 1977.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of O against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
