## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Canyon Day Community has been granted \$9,000.00 in Revenue Sharing Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Funds have not been expended, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement to extend the time period of six (6) months.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the period is extended for six (6) months from April, 1977 through October, 1977.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Sectionn16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
