RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Arizona Department of Transportation has had a revocable permit on the Indian Pine Maintenance Camp, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to renew the permit for five (5) years, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to collect the amount of \$2,944.00 from the first year from October 31, 1973 through November 3, 1976, and
- WHEREAS, the new five (5) year revocable permit is to be effective November 1, 1976 and expires October 31, 1981 at the rate of \$736.00 per year.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a revocable permit be issued starting November 1, 1976 and ending October 1, 1981 for \$736.00 per year.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$2,944.00 be collected for the period October 31, 1973 to November 1, 1976.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
