RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires that a 'Needs and Feasibility Study' be made for a White Mountain Apache Community College, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe requests that grant funds be made available under Public Law 93-638, and
- WHEREAS, it is estimated that \$25,000.00 will be needed for the study, and
- WHEREAS, the proposed starting date is to be July 1, 1977 and ending December 31, 1977, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe will assess the report progress about September 30, 1977 and evaluate the completed report in December of 1977.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman apply for a \$25,000.00 grant for the specific purpose of having a "Needs and Feasibility Study" for a White Mountain Apache Community College.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to sign any and all documents to consummate this requested grant under the authority of Public Law 93-638.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
