## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is great benefit being received from the Title X Sidwalk Project, and
- WHEREAS, there are areas in the communities still needing sidewalks, and
- WHEREAS, there is public works funds available from time to time to the Tribe or Bureau of Indian Affairs for this type of project.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe and the Agency look for sources of funding to construct more sidewalks.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that when funds are located, that sidewalks be constructed in each community.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
