RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to contract for the Fiscal Year for the Personnel Services of the Bureauof Indian Affairs Equipment Management System Shop at Whiteriver, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorized the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute the contract and/or amendments, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Chairman is to run concurrent with the term of the contract, March 9, 1977, to March 9, 1978. The annual estimate of the contract will be \$250,000.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to negotiate the Service Contract for the Fiscal Year 1977 and 1978, beginning March 9, 1977, and ending March, 1978.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to execute the contract and/or any amendments thereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the progress and content of the contract and/or any amendment will be reviewed before the Tribal Council at ninety (90) day intervals for the term of the contract.

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
