RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads requests permission to survey and construct a road from Cibecue to Grasshopper, Grasshopper to Oak Creek Stockman's, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees and accepts the recommendation of the Roads Department's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the White Mountain Apache Tribe grants permission to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads to survey and construct a road from Cibecue to Oak Creek Stockman's on Route 12.

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
