## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the new White Mountain Apache Community Health Representative Program Contract has been increased this year from \$205,000.00 to \$257,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, the 1977-78 program plan for the Community Health Representative Program calls for expansion of office facilities and two new emergency vehicles, and
- WHEREAS, the new Community Health Representative Contract approved by Indian Health Service includes monthly payments of \$628.00 for office facilities and \$400.00 for two emergency vehicles, and
- WHEREAS, the low bid on an office trailer for the program is \$27,000.00 and the cost of two van-type emergency vehicles is \$20,000.00; the Community Health Representative Program can pay \$12,000.00 towards the cost of the two vehicles from carryover funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approves the Tribal purchase of an office trailer and two emergency vehicles in the amount of \$35,000.00 to be leased to the Community Health Representative Program over a period of thirty-six (36) months.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby directs and authorizes an amendment of the Central Tribal Budget to provide for said \$35,000.00 expenditure.

The foregoing resolution was on March 10, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
