

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Boys' and Girls' Camps on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are summer work-study facilities provided by and for the children of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Boys' and Girls' Camps are in extreme need of repairs and a new commercial cook stove at Boys' Camp, and

WHEREAS, the Education Office is in dire need of furnitures, particularly two (2) office desks.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the unexpended balance of the Revenue Sharing Funds approved by Resolution No: 74-88, be modified and approved for general education needs and repairs, to wit:

- (a) Repairs, painting and garbage stand at Youth Camp
- (b) Commercial cook stove at Boys' Camp
- (c) Two office desks for Education Office

The foregoing resolution was on March 9, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


