RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to apply for Federal Assistance through the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration for the purpose of providing the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department with a law enforcement training program that will upgrade the quality of law enforcement on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee of the Tribe has proposed and reviewed the goals, impact, methods, and all costs of such a program, and has determined that \$32,091.00 is needed for these purposes from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration in order to create and operate the proposed program properly, and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee recommends to the Tribal Council that application be made for said federal funds in the amount of \$32,091.00, and that the Tribal Chairman be designated the authorized representative and contracting officer for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to receive and expend said federal funds, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered and reviewed the recommendations of the Law and Order Committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs that application be made for federal assistance from the U. S. Department of Justice, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration for \$32,091.00 as and for funding of a Police Department Training Project.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to prepare or execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 10, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
