RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has Revenue Sharing Savings of funds presently available, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that such savings and funds be utilized in the best interests of the reservation communities, and

WHEREAS, the Carrizo Community is in extreme need of a Television Booster antenna so that television reception may be facilitated in that community and so that Carrizo children may view television without undertaking unsafe or harmful activities in order to see television programs from atop nearby cliffs and mountains.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes and directs the expenditures of Revenue Sharing Savings and Funds, from those available up to the Grant Period eight (8) in the approximate amount of \$3,000.00, for the purpose of providing said funds to the Carrizo Community for the purchase of a Television Booster Antenna.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
