RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Apache Culture Center Committee is a Standing Committee of the Tribal Council, and

WHERFAS, the Apache Culture Center Committee has prepared and presented to the Tribal Council, a Plan of Operation which it desires to implement for the purpose of formally organizing the Arts and Crafts Section of the White Mountain Apache Culture Center, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the desirability and need for structuring an actively coordinated Arts and Crafts Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves and adopts the Plan of Operation of the White Mountain Apache Culture Center, Arts and Crafts Section, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
