RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-120 established the procedures to be used in expending funds from the Roads Suspense Account, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads will build the Forestdale road for Fort Apache Timber Company and Fort Apache Timber Company in turn will provide money for the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads to construct driveways to houses of tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry and Roads Committees have reviewed these projects and recommended that they be implemented.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) of Roads Suspense Account monies be made available by Fort Apache Timber Company for Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads to supervise and construct driveways to houses of tribal members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the payment procedures, as contained in Resolution No. 70-120, will be utilized to expend this two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00).

The foregoing resolution was on April 6, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
