- WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the Indian Health Service to transfer these water and sewage facilities for houses in the community of Whiteriver, Arizona has been adopted by the Housing Authority, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has requested an agreement by and between the Indian Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribe is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the transfer of domestic water-supply and sewage-disposal facilities for Indian homes in the community of Whiteriver, Arizona, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Project P.H. 72-150 and 72-014MH on file in the Chairman's Office and the Tribal Utility Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
