

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bean Pot located close to Rainbow City Community, and
WHEREAS, it has been determined that the actual construction was not on the
area described in Lease No. 14-20-OH52-63, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the lease be modified to reflect
the correct leased area.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that
the Superintendent and the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed
to modify Lease No. 14-20-OH52-63 to reflect the proper area where
the Bean Pot was constructed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the only modification authorized by this resolution is
the corrected surveyed area.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for
and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
