RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ernest and Luritta Perry have an existing homesite lease in the Indian Pine Junction area and a home financed by the Farmers Home Administration, and

WHEREAS, Ernest and Luritta Perry desire to assign their leasehold interest and accrued interest in the home to Leon Metts, a single man, and

WHEREAS, Leon Metts desires to assume the Farmers Home Administration loan on the property and has been qualified by the Farmers Home Administration for a Rural Housing Loan.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an assignment is hereby approved and the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary to approve the assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
