RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has in previous years operated certain contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Public Health Service on a cost reimbursable basis, and
- WHEREAS, the number of contracts with various agencies has increased to the point that the Tribe is unable to meet the cash needs of the various programs.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Public Health Service to provide cash advances for the operation of the various programs and contracts currently operated by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized and directed to sign any document necessary to institute advance payments for these programs and contracts.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
