

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised, and has considered, that it will be necessary to charge fees for admission and use of said swimming pool at a rate which will allow the Tribe to maintain a swimming recreation program, and also not discourage the public from utilizing the swimming facilities and program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the rates of twenty-five cents (25¢) per day, or ten cents (10¢) per session, during either the morning session from 10:00 a.m. to noon, or the afternoon session from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., upon recommendation of the Community Recreation Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the charging of said fees shall serve the interests of the tribal communities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the charging of fees to the public, for the use of the Tribal swimming pool at Whiteriver and approves the rates of twenty-five cents (25¢) per day per person, or ten cents (10¢) per person per session, during either the morning session from 10:00 a.m. to noon, or the afternoon session from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
