WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has requested that Indian Health Service plan a water and sanitation development in Alchesay Flats, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has a tentative location for the development, and


WHEREAS, the tentative location for the main line of the water supply will follow the powerline right-of-way.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they approve the general location of the proposed project to be constructed by the Indian Health Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any and all efforts for an early completion will be appreciated by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
