RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has implemented Youth Recreation Program as required by the Land Claim Distribution Program for the Tribe as published in the Federal Register, Vol. 41, No. 8, Tuesday, January 13, 1976 at page 1930.
- WHEREAS, the Plan further requires the inclusion of a Youth Recreation Budget in the regular Tribal Budget for each fiscal year.
- WHEREAS, a proposed budget in the amount of \$121,276.00, has been approved by the Land Claims Committee for the Youth Recreation Budget for fiscal year May 1, 1977, to April 30, 1978.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves the proposed 1977-78 Budget for the Community Recreation Program in the amount of \$121,276.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds for the said budget be programmed and released to the White Mountain Apache Tribe from its share of the Judgement Funds appropriated by the Act of Congress of October 31, 1972.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 1977-78 Central Tribe Budget be and is hereby amended to include expenditures in the amount of \$121,276.00.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
