RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Harrison and Vivian Kinney have an existing homesite lease in the McNary Community and a home financed by the Farmers Home Administration, and;
- WHEREAS, Harrison and Vivian Kinney desire to assign their leasehold interest and accrued interest in the home to Lilly Zahgotah Curley, and;
- WHEREAS, Lilly Zahgotah Curley desires to assume the Farmers Home Administration loan on the property and has been qualified by the Farmers Home Administration for a Rural Housing Loan.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an assignment is hereby approved and the Fort Apache Indian Agency are hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary to approve the assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
