

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Office of Native American Programs has received a grant approval in the amount of one thousand dollars to initiate a new summer feeding program at Seven-Mile, and;

WHEREAS, the actual funds for this program from the Arizona Summer Food Service Program will not be received until after the program must be initiated.

BE IT RESOLVED, that a loan in the amount of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) be made to the Office of Native American Programs to provide operating funds from Tribal monies currently on deposit with the First National Bank of Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these funds are to be reimbursed to the Tribe immediately upon receipt by ONAP from the Arizona Summer Food Service Program.


The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).


