RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council reviewed the proposed budget for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Queen; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council thought it fitting and proper to support the office of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Queen; and
- WHEREAS, the Queen and her office attends many festivities as tribal representatives;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the office of White Mountain Apache Tribal Queen be established a budget in the amount of \$7,000;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Budget for the office of the Queen be withdrawn from funds on deposit with the U.S. Treasury and that the Tribal Budget be amended to increase it to \$7,000;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required for this budget amendment.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
