RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed Tribal participation in the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the Tribal Council that benefits are received from the association with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to continue financial support;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$500 membership fee be paid to the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$500 be withdrawn from funds on deposit with the U.S. Treasury; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to make this budget amendment.

The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
