

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has requested a prospective permit; and

WHEREAS, a prospective permit is for exploration of gravel pits to be used on development of Highway 60; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the Arizona Department of Transportation be granted this prospective permit;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent and Tribal Chairman issue to the Arizona Department of Transportation a prospective permit for the location of desirable construction materials adjacent to highway 60; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the length of the prospective permit be ninety days effective September 1, 1977.


The foregoing resolution was on August 16, 1977, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (49 Stat. 984).
