RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for a good policy for Christmas tree cutting on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee having met recommended the following policy be adopted for Christmas tree cutting:

- 1. All commercial sales will be made through the Apache Enterprise at a \$1.00 per tree stumpage.
- 2. Churches, schools, and hospitals on the reservation will be given free use permits by the Branch of Forestry.
- 3. Non-Tribal residents or people working on the reservation be sold Christmas tree permits for \$1.00 per eight foot tree by the Branch of Forestry.
- 4. The Recreation Enterprise will be given half of the stumpage paid to the Tribe for policing the Christmas tree cutting.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the recommendations of the Forestry Committee as stated above are adopted as the Christmas Tree Policy for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 13, 1977 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
