

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Education Committee has requested a budget amendment of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), and

WHEREAS, the need for this budget amendment is to adequately finance eighty-five (85) students for higher education during the spring semester, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to support their youth and their endeavors of higher education.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the tribal budget be amended by \$10,000.00 to be used for the support of these eighty-five (85) students in their endeavors for higher education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding for this grant or budget amendment be taken from local funds not on deposit with the U. S. Treasury.


The foregoing resolution was on January 4, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
