

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. David Smith of the Waste Control Company in Pinetop, Arizona, has requested the permission of the Tribal Council to contact the Tribal Department Heads or officies and to survey residential areas for the purposes of determining garbage disposal needs throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith intends to prepare a waste control study based upon such survey information for the purpose of exploring the feasibility of containerized waste control and garbage pick-up as an alternative to on-reservation garbage dumps.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Mr. David Smith of the Waste Control Company, Pinetop, Arizona, to contact Tribal Department Heads or offices and to survey residential areas for the purposes of determining garbage disposal needs throughout the Reservation and of preparing a waste control study setting forth the feasibility of containerized waste control and garbage pick-up as an alternative to on-reservation garbage dumps.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said waste control study will be presented to the Tribal Council by Mr. David Smith within approximately six (6) weeks.


