

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Commercial Enterprise discussed with the Council, the need for gasoline and oil facilities at the Commercial Center, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that it would be a favorable addition to this Commercial Complex.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Enterprise budget be amended by \$50,000.00 to permit the construction of a gas and oil facility and storage and retail delivery for the Commercial Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this \$50,000.00 is part of the Central Tribal Budget amendment of November 19, 1977 of Two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this \$50,000.00 expenditure be added to the total capital outlay for the Whiteriver Commercial Center.

The foregoing resolution was on January 4, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
