

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the request from the Health, Welfare and Education for assistance in the housing for the elderly, and

WHEREAS, labor was available and the need for additional lumber to make repairs on present homes where the elderly are living, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considered that the tribe should contribute to this program for the elderly.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Enterprise of the Fort Apache Timber Company donate to the program for the housing of the elderly, one (1) bundle of 1x12; one (1) bundle of 1x4; one (1) bundle of 2x4; one (1) bundle of 2x6 lumber for the repair and maintenance of the elderly housing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that this contribution be made and the reflection of the donation is shown in Fort Apache Timber Company's financial records.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
