

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes the University of Arizona, College of Education, Division of Indian Program to write a grant proposal pursuant to which the Tribal Council will receive, manage, and disburse Indian Education Act, Title IV, Part B, funds for Apache Teacher Development Progra, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the Tribal Education Committee be the local Indian Education Committee as required in the Indian Education Act, Title IV, Part B.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to consumate the said proposal for Apache Teacher Development Program.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
